## PROGRAMME 2006

**SATURDAY 12<sup>th</sup> AUGUST.** Visit to Helmsley Walled Garden. Meet 14.30 at entrance to Garden.

Helmsley is on the A170 (Thirsk to Scarborough road). From the roundabout in the centre (at the corner of the market square), take the B1257 (Stokesley road), turn right at the T-junction, pass the church (on the right) and turn left into Cleveland Way. Car parks (pay and display) are on the left; head for the far side (bearing right, away from the town) where there is a footpath to the Garden entrance. (There is parking for the disabled just outside the entrance – follow the "Disabled Parking" sign from Cleveland Way.)

There is a café in the Garden and several cafes / hostelrys around the main square in Helmsley, and also a superb old-fashioned grocer who makes delicious picnic sandwiches to order.
